We encourage families to attend 9:30 a.m. Mass. Class will begin immediately following Mass and end at 11:25 a.m.

To register your student for Faith Formation, please complete and return the following forms (with payment) to the Faith Formation Office:

2. Copy of Baptismal Certificate if not baptized at St. George
3. Parental Option Form for Child Protection In-servicing
4. Authorization Form for Photographing
